


"In Flanders fields the poppies blow..."

These are the opening words of Col. John McCrae's immortal poem dedicated to the memory of the men and women who served, fought and died in France during World War I, the poppies of which he wrote have become the true symbol of all those who have given their lives in our nation's wars.

The poppy has become recognized as the memorial flower in countries throughout the world. It is distributed by veterans organizations in Europe, North America, and in most of the countries of the British Commonwealth.

Since 1922, the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States has conducted an annual distribution of the "Buddy" Poppy to raise funds for its charitable programs on behalf of the needy and disabled veterans, and the surviving family members of deceased veterans.

Exemption of Excise Tax for 100% Disabled Veterans



DID YOU KNOW?

100% disabled veterans qualify for an excise tax exemption for vehicles registered in their name.

Veterans meeting the criteria for a disabled veteran plate **do not have to be issued the disabled veteran plate to qualify for the excise tax exemption.**

If the veteran chooses another class of plate, they must pay the registration fee.



Maine Bureau of Veterans' Services

Veterans' Emergency Financial Assistance Program (VEFAP)

The Maine Bureau of Veterans' Services have created VEFAP for veterans who suffer an emergency and do not have sufficient savings or access to other financial assistance to resolve it. Examples of grant assistance (up to a \$2,000) for veterans who are Maine residents include - To prevent or resolve the veteran from being homeless; vehicle repair to maintain employment; illness of the veteran or family member that results in hardship; damage to the veterans home due to fire, flood, or hurricane that is not covered by insurance, up to \$500 for a dental emergency (suffering pain and/or infection), and any other condition that puts the veteran at risk of not having the basic necessities of food, shelter, or safety. 




