I wanted to share some information about the VA's patient portal, My Healthevet. My HealtheVet is the VA's patient portal for 24/7 access to online medical records and services. From the convenience of any computer on the internet, Veterans can:

- Securely message healthcare teams
- Refill prescriptions with the click of a key, track prescription shipping
- Check appointments and receive email appointment reminders
- Schedule and request appointments for primary care or mental health
- Review lab results, radiology, and other tests
- Download healthcare records and review provider notes.
- Download medical images like X-rays, mammograms, CTs, and MRIs.
- **Use our trusted and extensive Veterans Health Library.**

REGISTER or Sign In at: My HealtheVet Premium Upgrade / Authentication to use all features can be done at any VA Maine primary care office, the Togus Release of Information desk, and with most front desks of outpatient services. You can also call our coordination to do this by video connections with our coordinator.

Military Women Across the Nation \$1,000 College Scholarship Rules & Application



The 2023 essay topic is

"What Were the Challenges Faced by Military Women Who Served in Vietnam During the Vietnam War?"

APPLICANTS WHO DO NOT ADHERE TO **ALL INSTRUCTIONS** WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.

Applicant Eligibility:

1. Must have a 3.2 or better Grade Point Average (GPA) on a 4.0 scale.
2. Must be a high school senior or undergraduate college student.
3. Entries must be submitted by **1 April 2023. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
4. Military personnel and veterans **MAY NOT APPLY FOR THIS SCHOLARSHIP.**

Application Package MUST INCLUDE the following:

1. Completed Application.
 2. Copy of all transcripts pertaining to current course of study to include academic standing.
- NOTE: To protect personal information applicants are directed to mark out all references to social security numbers on high school or college transcripts.**
3. An essay of 1,000 to 1,500 words in length written on the above topic. The essay must be the applicant's own work; be submitted in .doc or .docx format, and include documented evidence (including a bibliography) of both research and an interview with at least one military woman. Applicants are encouraged to contact military women in recruiting offices, at military bases, reserve units, etc. to enhance the research.
 4. The entire Application Package shall be submitted in one email to include **separate attachments** for the following:
 - (1) Completed Application
 - (2) Transcripts (must be legible)
 - (3) Applicant's essay (in .doc or .docx format)

Each attached file must include the applicant's last name and first initial as part of the file name and ALL correspondence must include the applicant's name in the subject line.

5. Email the Application Package and/or any questions to the Scholarship Chair at:

Application Package Submission DEADLINE is 1 April 2023.

Applicants will be notified in June 2023 of the results.

The scholarship will be paid jointly to the scholarship recipient AND his/her college.

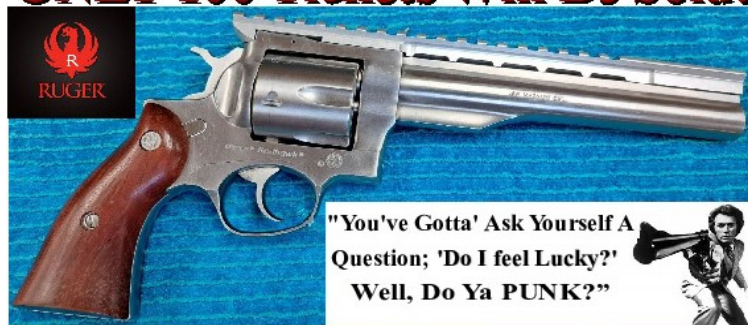

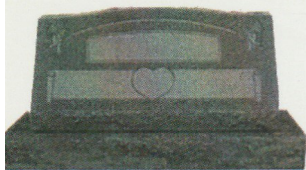

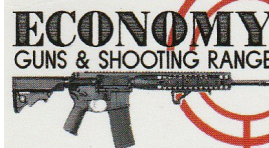

EDWARD STEPHEN RUBLESKY, 75 of Highland Plantation, Maine and formerly of Marlborough, Massachusetts, passed away on February 10, 2023 in Augusta, Maine at the VA Togus Medical Center after battling cancer. Eddie was born on July 2, 1947 in Cambridge, Massachusetts. Eddie was the son of Vito A. and Helen Rublesky of New Hampshire. Eddie was the brother of his beloved late sister, Palette M. Rublesky. Eddie had a special friend, the love of his life, Donna Hood and spent approximately 15 years with her until she passed in 2010. 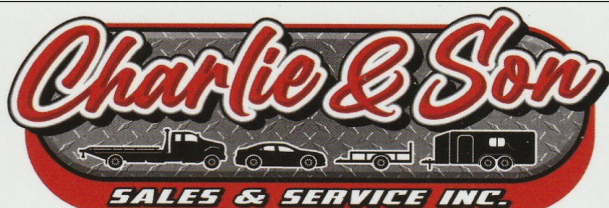

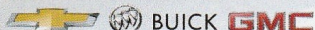
